Sweet Home Alabama

Alabama is awash in landmarks, museums and historic sites that offer an unparalleled look at events that shaped the nation. The birthplace of Helen Keller, the turning points of the civil rights movement, battlegrounds that determined America's fate – each place documents the trials and triumphs of our past.

## Centuries of History

From antebellum architecture to Native American mounds, there are stories to be told all across the state. Equally fascinating are the state's amazing collections of regional art and artifacts, such as the Birmingham Museum of Art, Auburn's Jule Collins Smith Museum of Fine Art and the Montgomery Museum of Fine Arts.

For a different spin on history, visit Calera's **Heart of Dixie Railroad Museum**, which preserves, restores and operates railway equipment significant to the history of not just Alabama, but also the entire nation. Or visit the **Alabama Department of Archives and History** in Montgomery to research government archives, private historical records and family genealogy. It is the oldest state-funded archives in the United States, and the department's museum boasts historical artifacts, rotating exhibits and hands-on galleries for kids.

## Civil War Sites

From the telegram ordering the first shots at **Fort Sumter** to the last major battle of that bitter conflict, Alabama played a pivotal role in America's Civil War saga. After Abraham Lincoln was elected President of the United States, delegates from Southern states that had seceded met in the Alabama State Capitol in February 1861. Within a few days, they had written a constitution to create the Confederate States of America and elected Jefferson Davis of Mississippi its president. You can stand on the spot where Davis received the oath of office and tour the restored Capitol, as well as the **First White House of the Confederacy** across the street.

The most significant naval action of the war occurred in Mobile Bay, the only Southern port still open in 1864. Tour **Fort Morgan** near **Gulf Shores** and **Fort Gaines** on **Dauphin Island**, where Union Adm. Farragut gave his famous "Damn the torpedoes" order that led his fleet to victory.

East of **Clanton**, the 103-acre **Confederate Memorial Park** began as the only home for Confederate veterans. Today, you can see uniforms, weapons and graves, and learn about the old soldiers who spent their lives there. Some 18 re-enactments take place annually across the state.

The **Alabama Civil War Trail** brochure, available online for download or at any Alabama Welcome Center, has listings for dozens of museums, cemeteries and battlefield sites.

## Historic Homes

From sprawling plantation houses to humble cabins where legends were born, Alabama's historic homes also have much to share. In the luxurious estates that predate the Civil War, voices from years past echo among the gleaming hardwood floors, stately Corinthian columns and ornate furnishings. In the Gulf Coast region, discover Mobile's well-preserved homes, from the Italianate style of the Richards DAR House to the Creole cottage-style farmhouse of the Carlen House Museum. Head to Clayton in the River Heritage region and visit the Octagon House, the only antebellum example of octagon-style architecture remaining in the state.

In Tuskegee, pay tribute to Booker T. Washington and Tuskegee University at The Oaks. The 1899 home was built by students and faculty with bricks made by the students. Or walk in the steps of courage at Ivy Green in Tuscumbia, where Helen Keller was born. Built in 1820, the site hosts a performance of The Miracle Worker each summer to retell her remarkable story.

### *Native American Heritage*

Explore Alabama's rich Native American history at the **Indian Mound and Museum** in Florence. The mound is the largest domiciliary mound in the Tennessee Valley, and the museum houses a large collection of Native American relics found in the area, with chronological displays and explanations of artifacts.

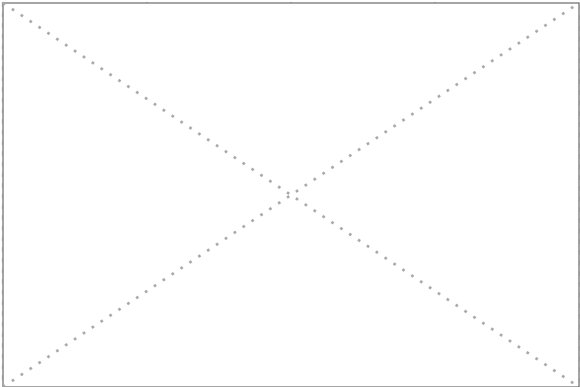
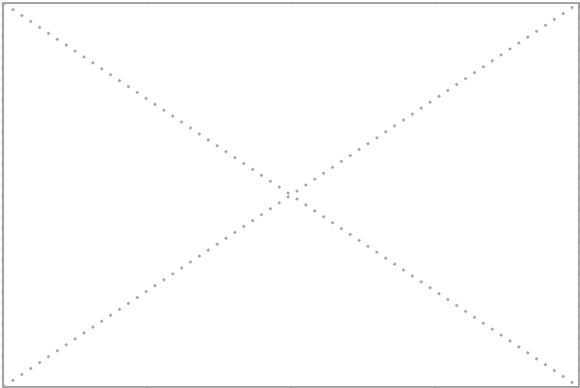
In **Fort Mitchell**, check out the **Chattahoochee Indian Heritage Center**. Journey to **Moulton** for the **Oakville Indian Mounds Education Center** or to **Moundville Archaeological Park** near **Tuscaloosa**. **Horseshoe Bend National Military Park**, located near **Dadeville**, is where Gen. Andrew Jackson defeated Chief Menawa and the Upper, or Red Stick, Creeks in 1814.

In **Huntsville**, don't miss a chance to experience the warmth and elegance of **Cotton Row**, housed in a cotton exchange building that dates back to 1821. And if you're looking for a truly unique North Alabama eating experience, trek to downtown **Decatur** to try the incredible steaks and seafood of **Simp McGhee's**, named for a legendary riverboat captain who lost his license for recklessly braving rapids on the Tennessee River.

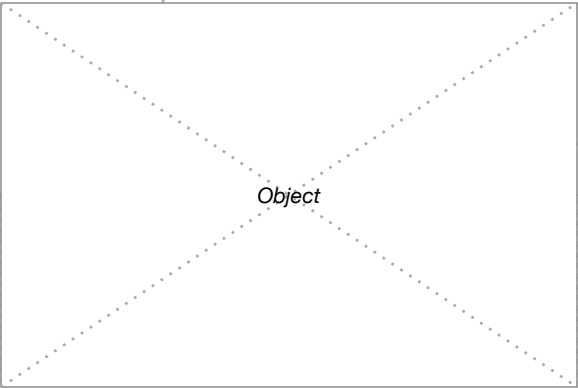

We love sports, and that's just one reason our state has produced so many legendary athletes. But it's more than that. It's the history, the venues, the small towns, the people, maybe even the dirt itself.

### Legendary Sports

You may know us for one of the winningest coaches in college football, but we invite you to dig deeper. Celebrate the childhood home of track star Jesse Owens. Sit in the stands where the first integrated professional baseball game was played. Explore the backstories and attend some high school, college or minor league games. You might just discover your favorite sport's next big star.

Begin exploring the Alabama sports legacy at the **Alabama Sports Hall of Fame**, a three-story facility in Birmingham where sports legends Jesse Owens, Hank Aaron, Joe Louis, Carl Lewis and Willie Mays are immortalized. Learn all about Jesse Owens at the **Jesse Owens Memorial Park** in **Danville**, where you'll find the **Jessé Owens Museum** and an authentic re-creation of his childhood home.

At **Tuscaloosa's Paul W. Bryant museum**, you can hear the philosophy of the University of Alabama coach and view photos, memorabilia and films of major Crimson Tide football victories. Or, watch Bo Jackson going "over the top" against the Crimson Tide in 1982 at the **Jonathan B. Lovelace Athletic Muséum** in **Auburn**.

### Football

Alabama's legendary athletic reputation centers around football, and it's easy to see why. We've played some of the best football this country has ever seen, from Paul "Bear" Bryant's legendary Crimson Tide teams to Auburn's Bo Jackson and his unforgettable Heisman Trophy run.

**Alabama's Bryant-Denny Stadium** (capacity: 101,821) and **Auburn's Jordan-Hare Stadium** (87,451) are among the largest football stadiums in the country and host exciting SEC football action every fall. Down in **Mobile**, you'll find college football's biggest all-star game, the Senior Bowl, an annual event that draws more NFL scouts and coaches than any other event of its kind.

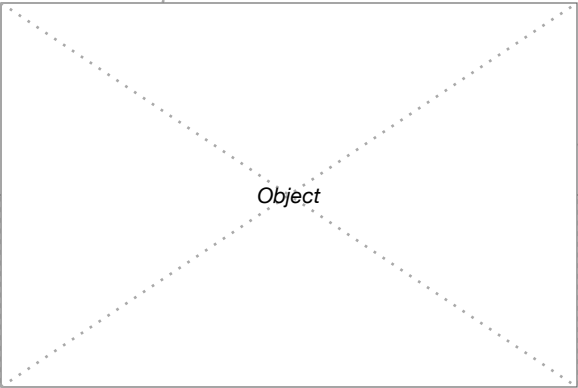

### Baseball

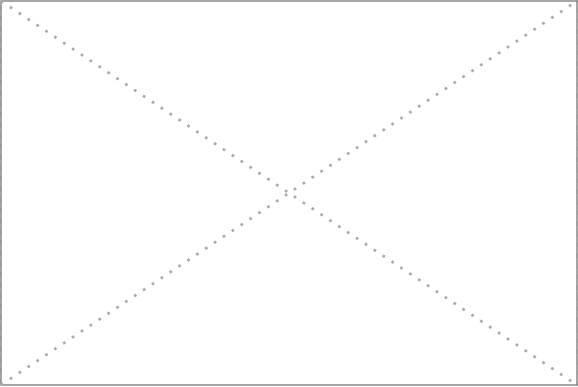
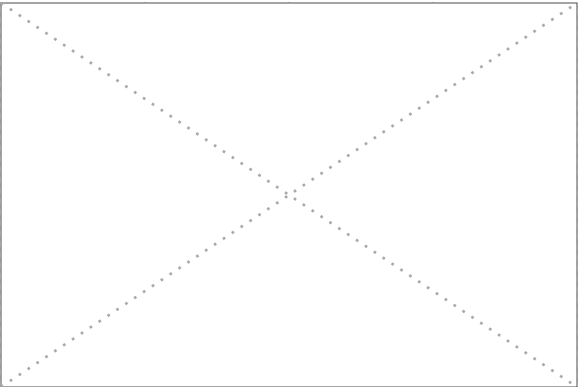
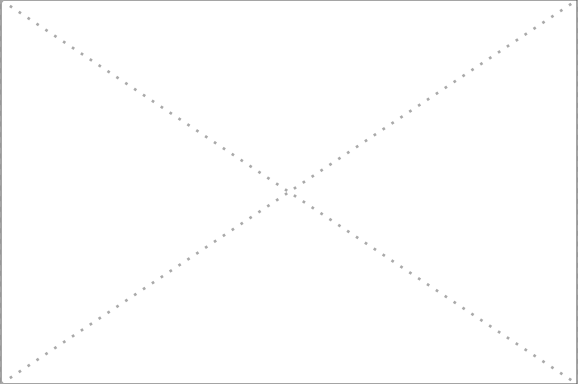

## Motorsports

Watch NASCAR superstars battle three wide in the turns at the world's fastest and most competitive superspeedway each spring and fall. Year-round, tour the track, visit the **International Motorsports Hall of Fame** or pay homage to local legend Davey Allison by taking a stroll around the **Talladega Walk of Fame**.

The **Barber Vintage Motorsports Museum** houses the world's largest motorcycle collection, as well as race cars and other racing artifacts. Outside, the impressive 2.3-mile road course hosts some of the most challenging racing events in the world, including the **Indy Grand Prix of Alabama** and the **AMA Triumph Superbike Championship**.

Thrills abound when **Orange Beach** hosts the **Offshore Powerboat Association World Championships**. Spectators also enjoy the beach, food and plenty of entertainment at this family-friendly event.

The firm handshakes, the warm smiles, the generations of stories behind each delicious dish and handmade craft.

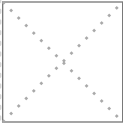

## Year-round Golf

Alabama boasts warmth and sunshine for the greater part of the year, making it a golf lover's paradise. From the **Robert Trent Jones Golf Trail**, featuring 26 courses and 468 holes, to world-class golf along the Gulf Coast, the state offers golfers an experience unlike any other.

## Robert Trent Jones Golf Trail

Hit a tee shot from a cliff overlooking the Tennessee River, over what seems to be a bottomless ravine. Stand in the fairway and aim at twin greens bisected by an 80-foot waterfall. From a bluff above the Alabama River, watch your drive sail through the clouds then fall to a ribbon of fairway 200 feet below. These are the kinds of shots you always remember – the ones that give you that extra zing of adrenaline before and after you swing. You'll find these breathtaking shots up and down the world-famous Robert Trent Jones Golf Trail in Alabama, which helped transform the state into one of the most popular golf destinations in the world. Others have tried to copy the concept, but Alabama's trail is the unrivaled original.

**Hoover's Ross Bridge**, the Trail's crown jewel, opened in 2006 and became home to the **Champions Tour's Regions Charity Classic**. Nestled in the peaceful valley of Shades Mountain, the wide-open layout gives golfers variety and options, including the chance to play an 8,200-yard course if you're feeling feisty. It is just down the road from **Birmingham's** Oxmoor Valley, a 54-hole facility.

Other Trail sites with 54 holes include **Capitol Hill** in **Prattville**, **Grand National** in **Opelika**, **Magnolia Grove** in **Mobile** and **Hampton Cove** in **Huntsville**. Several others have 36 holes, like **The Shoals** in **Florence**, **Silver Lakes** in **Anniston**, **Highland Oaks** in **Dothan**, **Cambrian Ridge** in **Greenville** and **Lakewood** in **Point Clear**.

The Trail stops are spaced conveniently along the state's major roads, so you are never far away from one of those memorable golf shots. Most Trail sites are now associated with luxury **Marriott** hotels and spas, making stay-and-play packages convenient and affordable.

While the Trail gains worldwide attention for its quantity and quality, the state is blessed with many other golf treasures.

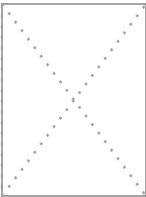
The **Gulf Shores Golf Association**, an affiliate of courses in southwestern Alabama, can help arrange vacations that include world-class golf, sugar-white beaches and charter fishing expeditions. **Kiva Dunes**, consistently one of the state's top courses, is part of the GSGA, as is **Cotton Creek** and **Cypress Bend**, the only layouts in the state designed by the legendary Arnold Palmer. **Peninsula**, **Rock Creek**, **Glenlakes**, **TimberCreek** and **Soldiers Creek** are other popular coastal golf retreats.

**Limestone Springs** in **Oneonta** and **FarmLinks Golf Resort** in **Sylacauga** are two relatively new courses that consistently garner rave reviews. Old favorites like **StillWaters Golf Club** in **Dadeville**, **Point Mallard** in **Decatur** and **Goose Pond Colony** in **Scottsboro** remain as popular as ever.

Alabama's state park system also offers some fun and inexpensive golf options like **Gulf State Park** in **Gulf Shores** and **Oak Mountain** in **Birmingham**. **Montgomery's Lagoon Park** and **Mobile's Azalea City** are challenging municipal layouts.

Whether you stay on the Trail or venture to some of the state's other hideaways, it's definitely worth the golf trip to Alabama.

## Science & Discovery

Alabama is a destination for explorers of all ages. Each year, hundreds of thousands of visitors follow man's journey into space at the **U.S. Space & Rocket Center** in **Huntsville**. They experience larger-than-life IMAX films at **Birmingham's McWane Science Center** and get back to nature at numerous natural and environmental education centers.

Whether you want to see a space shuttle up close or learn about the science of our solar system, let Alabama be the launch pad for your family's sense of wonder.

## U.S. Space & Rocket Center

**Huntsville's** role in the U.S. space program began in the 1950s, when a team of scientists designed and tested the rockets that eventually put man on the moon. This led to the establishment of NASA's first public location for visitors, the **U.S. Space & Rocket Center**, which opened in 1970.

Today, the center is a Smithsonian Institution Affiliate and one of Alabama's top attractions, housing the 363-foot Apollo-era Saturn V rocket and hundreds of artifacts from mankind's journeys to space. Simulators such as the Space Shot and G-Force Accelerator let visitors experience what it's like to be an astronaut. The center also hosts highly popular programs like **Space Camp** and **Aviation Challenge**, which each year attract students from all over the world who are interested in careers in science, math, engineering, robotics, aerospace and aviation.

## Science and Discovery Centers

As a state known for medicine, manufacturing and natural beauty, it makes sense that Alabama's science museums and education centers would provide a wide range of information and interactive experiences.

Spend a day at **McWane Science Center**, home of an IMAX dome theater and four floors of interactive exhibits. Or see North American animals in realistic settings at the **Mann Wildlife Learning Museum** in **Montgomery**, where three-sided viewing provides personal encounters. Learn how nuclear energy is produced at **Farley Nuclear Electric Generating Plant** or visit other unique attractions such as the **Southern Museum of Flight**, the **Alabama Museum of the Health Sciences** and the **Southern Environmental Center**.

From wildlife to aircraft, Alabama's science and education scene offers a little something for everyone – whether you're looking to learn a little or just have a lot of fun.

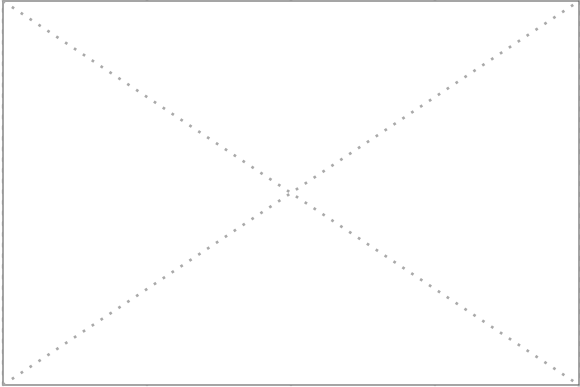
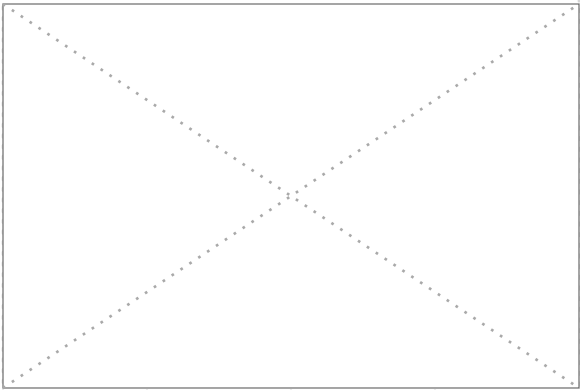

Alabama was at the heart of the civil rights struggle in the 1950s and '60s, an era of triumph and tragedy that redefined our nation. Celebrate this hard-fought legacy at landmarks across Alabama.

### Civil Rights

Rosa Parks refused to move to the back of a bus in Montgomery. More than 3,000 demonstrators gathered in **Selma** for a march to the Capitol to demand voting rights, and 20,000 others joined them along the way. In **Birmingham**, four little girls lost their lives to a bomb attack at **16th Street Baptist Church**.

These were the difficult turning points that finally brought civil rights to America, and there is no better place to learn about this historic struggle than in Alabama.

### Landmarks and Museums

Midway along the **Selma to Montgomery National Historic Trail** on U.S. Highway 80 in **Hayneville** lies the \$10 million **Lowndes County Interpretive Center**. The museum exhibits depict a wide range of events, including the establishment of “Tent City,” which housed families dislodged by white landowners in Lowndes County. In downtown **Montgomery**, The **Civil Rights Memorial Center** features multiple exhibits, including a Wall of Tolerance that allows visitors to sign a pledge to promote racial justice.

At the **Rosa Parks Museum** in **Montgomery**, you can step back in time and see a 1955 Montgomery city bus for yourself, or visit the nearby **Dexter Parsonage Museum** on the site where Martin Luther King Jr. lived while leading the Montgomery bus boycott. Learn about the movement’s foot soldiers at the **National Voting Rights Museum** in **Selma** or about the secret life of Booker T. Washington at the **Tuskegee Human & Civil Rights Multicultural Center**.

And don’t miss a chance to visit the nation’s largest civil rights museum, the **Birmingham Civil Rights Institute**, which boasts 58,000 square feet of archives, galleries, community meeting rooms and exhibit spaces.

Many civil rights-era sites have been preserved and made open to the public. **Birmingham's Civil Rights District** is home to Kelly Ingram Park, a site where marchers and activists came together in protest. Nearby is **16th Street Baptist Church**, where Ku Klux Klan members killed four young girls in a 1963 bombing.

Walk across **Selma’s** Edmund Pettus Bridge, the site of a 1965 violent confrontation that helped rally national support for the civil rights movement, or visit the airfield where the **Tuskegee Airmen**, the first African-American military pilots, trained during World War II. In **Montgomery**, stop by the **Dexter Avenue King Memorial Baptist Church**, where Martin Luther King Jr. was the pastor from 1954-1960.

The aromas filling the room are reminiscent of Italy and the Mediterranean: simple Venetian fish dishes, Tuscan roasts, Moroccan tagines and flavors from throughout the Mediterranean basin. This is Bottega Restaurant. Open in 1988 in the historic Bottega Favorita building on Highland Avenue, this is the second in Frank Stitt's family of restaurants. Frank, a four-time James Beard Award nominee, wanted a place to work with the sun-drenched flavors of the region without imposing on the existing French influence of his first restaurant, Highlands Bar & Grill. Café Bottega is patterned after bustling Italian trattorias. An open kitchen and wood-fired brick oven produces pizzas topped with farm eggs, mascarpone prosciutto and and Bottega's roast loin with polenta, tomato chutney and Venetian spinach. Bottega and Café Bottega are two of four restaurants owned by Frank Stitts in Birmingham's Southside neighborhood.

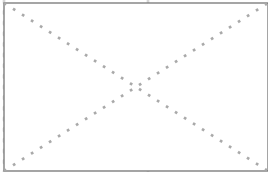


## Montgomery

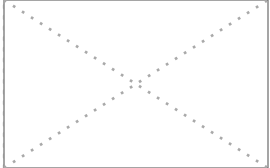


## Tuskegee & Phenix City

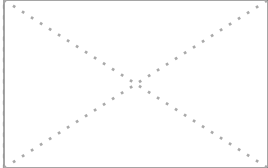


## The Wiregrass

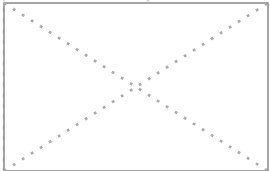


## Montgomery and Selma

## Planning Your Visit

Want to catch the beach at peak season or time your trip for the beauty of Alabama’s fall color change? Need help planning your route? You've come to the right place. Find climate information, suggested road trips and tons of travel resources to help plan your trip to Alabama.

### Alabama's Climate

The majority of Alabama’s days are warm and sunny. Rainfall across the state is lowest in October and highest in March. Spring comes early, with a brilliant palette of colors and temperatures around 60 degrees Fahrenheit (15 degrees Celsius) daily by March. Summer days average in the 80s F (mid-20s C), with periods of heat in the 90s F (32 C) peaking in July.

In the cooler months of September, October and November, you usually won’t need more than a sweater or light jacket to stay warm. Severely cold weather is rare, and we don’t get much snow, even in the higher elevations of North Alabama. For Birmingham, the average low temperature in January is 33 F degrees, while the high is 54 F. In the coastal city of Mobile, the average January low is 40 F and the high 61 F.

Hurricane season extends from May to October in Alabama, while conditions for tornadoes are most common in March, April and November. 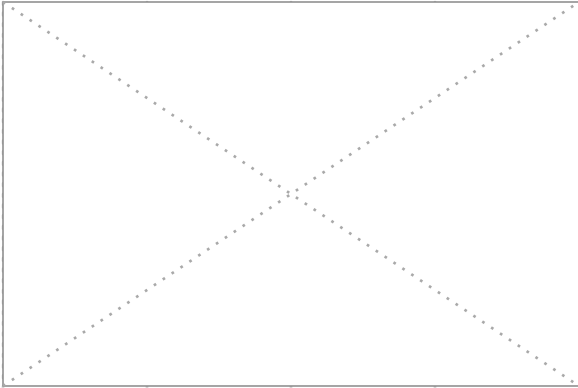
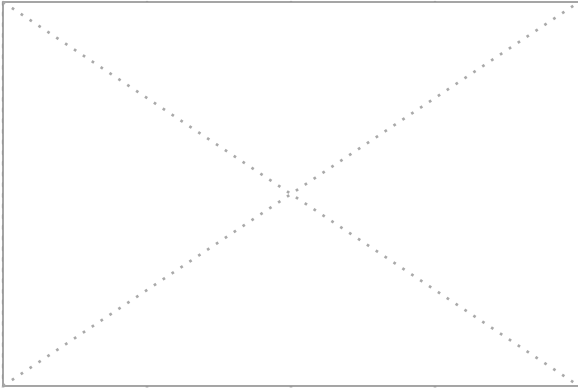
#### Hunting

## Local Laws

While Alabama’s laws are largely similar to those across the U.S., the state does have a variety of laws that visitors should be aware of, from highway safety guidelines to restrictions on alcohol and tobacco.

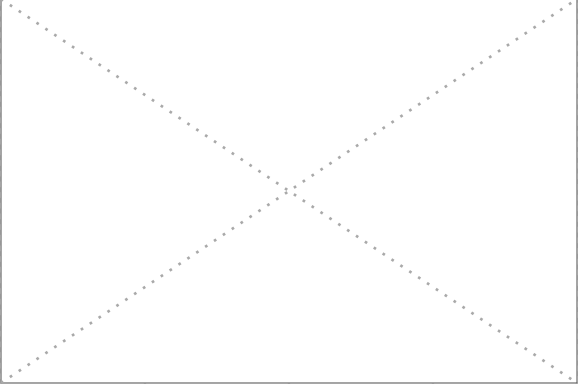
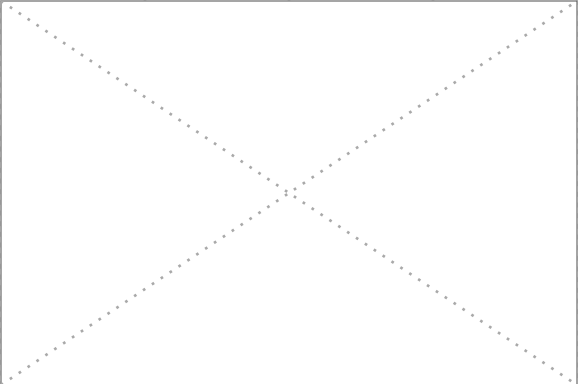
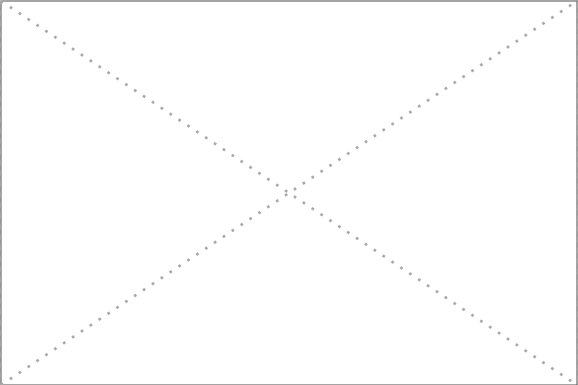
### Important Documents for Travelers

For your safety and convenience, please have the following travel documents with you at all times when visiting Alabama:

- Valid driver's license or non-driver photo ID from your home state or country
- Passports for all travelers, including minors, in your party (if visiting from outside the United States)
- Visas for all travelers, including minors, in your party (if visiting from outside the United States)
- Health insurance or travel insurance information

### Driving Laws

- Speed limits: Alabama's maximum speed limit is 70 mph on interstate highways unless otherwise marked.
- Lights on when raining: Alabama requires the use of low-beam headlights when driving in the rain.
- Passing and turning: Alabama permits right turns on red after making a full stop and seeing that the way is clear, unless a sign forbidding such turns is posted. All traffic in all lanes must stop for school and church buses while passengers get on or off. Buses are marked with flashing lights and stop signals.
- Accidents: All accidents should be investigated by a law enforcement officer. Drivers involved in an accident are required to give first aid to others involved.
- Safety belts and child restraints: Alabama law requires all front-seat occupants to buckle up. In front and back seats, children under 6 must occupy federally approved safety restraints. Five-year-olds may use safety belts instead of child safety seats, which are mandatory for children 4 and under.
- Emergency vehicles: Drivers must yield to emergency vehicles. Pull as far to the right as possible and stop to let the emergency vehicle pass.
- Texting while driving: Cell phone texting or emailing while driving is illegal in Alabama, with state fines ranging from \$25 to \$75. Several cities have enacted their own penalties, as well. For your own safety and that of other drivers, do not send or view text messages while driving.
- Move Over Law: Alabama law requires all motorists to move over when approaching emergency vehicles that are stopped with their flashing emergency lights activated.
  - 4 or more lanes: Move over one lane or slow down to at least 15 mph below the posted speed limit if it is not possible to move over.
  - 2 lanes: Move over as far as possible without leaving the lane and slow down to at least 15 mph below the posted speed limit.
- Motorcycle regulations:
  - Safety helmets are required while driving a motorcycle in Alabama.
  - Insurance: Compulsory liability (Minimum limits 20/40/10)
  - Eye protection: Not required
  - Daytime use of headlight: Modulating headlight permitted
  - Passenger seat: Required if carrying passenger
  - Passenger age limit: No age limit
  - Helmet speakers: No restrictions
  - Mirror: One required
  - Turn signals: None required
  - Muffler: No acoustical criteria
  - Handlebar height: Maximum of 15 inches above seat
  - Lane splitting: Motorcycles cannot pass other vehicles in the same lane. Motorcycles also cannot be driven between lanes of traffic or between adjacent lanes or rows of vehicles.

## Alabama Alcohol and Tobacco Laws

The minimum age for buying, drinking or possessing alcohol in Alabama is 21. Visitors planning to drink should be sure to carry an official government ID, such as a passport. Alcohol sales are restricted on Sundays across Alabama, with some counties and cities allowing Sunday alcohol sales during specific hours. Some Alabama counties are completely “dry,” meaning that no alcohol can be purchased any day of the week. To find out about alcohol rules in the counties you’ll be visiting, check with local businesses (such as the hotel or inn where you’ll be staying) or a state Welcome Center. It’s illegal to bring alcoholic beverages into Alabama if they were purchased outside Alabama. Drivers may be charged with driving under the influence of alcohol if the alcohol content in their blood is 0.08 percent or above. It is unlawful for someone under the age of 19 to purchase, use, possess or transport tobacco or tobacco products. Smoking restrictions vary by city and establishment, but the Alabama Clean Indoor Air Act does prohibit smoking in public places unless there is a designated smoking area.

- **Hunting:** Alabama is famous for its wide array of hunting opportunities, but all visiting hunters and trappers are required to have a Nonresident Alabama Hunting License. - **Fishing:** If you’re looking forward to fishing Alabama’s lakes, rivers or coastal waters, be sure to pick up an Alabama Fishing License in advance. Different licenses are required for freshwater or saltwater fishing. Learn more from the Licenses section of [OutdoorAlabama.com](#).
- **Boating:** Adults visiting from outside Alabama are not required to obtain an Alabama Boating License unless they plan on operating a watercraft for more than 45 days. Learn more from the Boating section of [OutdoorAlabama.com](#).
